Dear Youth Sponsor,

It is time to get your teens ready to come out for the 40th annual HARVEST TEEN RALLY! We have been working hard to get the farm prepared for **September 11**. Please keep in mind that the day is designed for those that are in 7–12th grade. Registration for the day begins at 8:30 a.m. followed by a meet-and-greet service from 9-9:30 a.m. The day will wrap up with a service ending around 5:00 p.m.

We are privileged to have Jeremiah Clark with us this year! Jeremiah is a former Youth Pastor and is now an Evangelist, so he knows the needs of teenagers and how to challenge them from God's Word. Your youth group will also be blessed by the music in each of the three services with a group from Maranatha Baptist University.

HARVEST TEEN RALLY FANATIC YOUTH GROUP: We will be rewarding the youth group that brings the highest percentage of increase of teens from the previous year with the **HARVEST RALLY FANATIC** award. The winning youth group will receive pizza for the whole youth group at the end of the day! A plaque will also be made and presented to your church following the Rally.

TEEN REGISTRATION FORM: Each teen needs to have a form filled out and signed by a parent or guardian to participate in all of the activities. Go to www.harvestteenrally.com and click on the FORMS tab where you can download and then print the TEEN REGISTRATION FORM.

ADULT REGISTRATION FORM: Each adult that comes to the Rally as a sponsor or a worker needs to fill one of these out. This helps us know who is bringing teens and who is helping us minister to the teens throughout the day. Be sure that if you know of people from your church that are coming to work they do this as well. Go to our website www.harvestteenrally.com and click on the FORMS tab where you can download and then print the ADULT REGISTRATION FORM.

HAVING THESE FORMS FILLED OUT AHEAD OF TIME HELPS TO MAKE THE REGISTRATION PROCESS GO MORE EFFICIENTLY.

Please try to pre-register your teams for the volleyball and 3-on-3 basketball tournaments ahead of time. This can be done by going to www.harvestteenrally.com and sending an email with your church name, address, and number of teams for each of these tournaments.

WHAT TO WEAR: Teens should dress according to their church's code of attire for such activities. Be sure clothing allows teens to be ready to play games and have fun while maintaining a sense of decency. Please keep in mind that this is a working farm so the terrain may be a little rough at times. The weather can also be unpredictable so be prepared!

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME: Alcohol, drugs, tobacco, fireworks, guns and ammunition, and other weapons including pocket knives are not permitted on the premises.

WHAT TO BRING: Be sure teens bring their registration form with a parent or guardian signature and **\$20 for registration** which covers most of the activities and lunch. They may want to bring some extra money for the concession stand and several of the camps and colleges have items for sale as well. Be sure everyone comes prepared with a Bible and an attitude that is ready to listen to God's Word three times throughout the day. Make sure your teens invite their friends as this is a great outreach opportunity. Let's fill those buses and vans up!
